PROGRAM

Our speaker today was Carolyn "Bunny" Welsh, Sheriff of Chester County. (For longtime members, Bunny is the daughter of John Welsh, who was President-Elect of our club, but who had a fatal heart attack before he could become President.) Born & raised in Upper Darby, Bunny studied criminal justice at Temple; she ran her own business, Hercom, for many years & served as President of the Concordville Rotary Club. When she ran for sheriff, she emphasized her strong business & executive background, which would give her a real advantage in running such a large organization. Voters responded, agreeing it was important to have someone with administrative experience as well as law-enforcement background in the position. When she was elected, Bunny was the only woman sheriff in Pennsylvania. The duties of Sheriff vary from county to county. In Chester County, Bunny has a staff of 85 & works for the court of common pleas. If you get a visit from

someone from her office, you have been sued or are otherwise in trouble. Last year, her office served 12,000 civil processes & transferred 8,000 prisoners. They issued 15,000 gun permits—double the previous year's total.

Bunny gives many speeches, talking to groups like ours, discussing public safety, & speaking at schools about anti-bullying programs.
