WellSpring owns all the necessary movie equipment, and the Timberland Libraries partnered to offer crafts for children at every movie.</b></p> <p><b>We are considering a few changes to our Movies event this year. Previously hosted in the Ilwaco Park, our Movies had to begin later in the evening. We hope to move the event to the Ilwaco Fire Hall or other similar site, an indoor location that will allow us to start the event earlier, drawing more families with young children. As well, weather won't have such an impact with an indoor location as it previously had.</b></p> <p><b>The Timberland Libraries have agreed to partner with us again. WellSpring would very much appreciate Rotary's continued support for this popular event. We are asking Rotary to fund the cost of the movies, which for four weeks should come to just under \$1800.00 (exact dollar amounts will be available once the movies have been selected, as prices vary).</b></p> <p><b>We expect to count more families and more children, with a greater overall increase in attendance. Last year Movies in the Park provided a free family activity for approximately 150 community members, which WellSpring will not be able to continue without outside support.</b></p> |  |
